In maths, the children have been finding fractions of amounts: halves, quarters, thirds and tenths. They found it challenging to find three quarters or two thirds of an amount and we will keep working on this. The children are doing well with their times tables, please continue to test them.

The children completed a test of 100 high frequency words this week, it was interesting to see the ones they are still finding a challenge. Generally these are the homophones such as: they're, their, there, where, were.

This week in English, the children wrote a character description of the Queen. They also tried 'Turkish Delight,' which helped them to make a poster (using persuasive language) advertising the chocolate bar version. The children also wrote great persuasive letters to the Queen of Narnia, asking her to stop being so mean.

This week, the children had great fun learning about light, they even understood how a shadow is formed. We went on a shadow hunt around the school looking for the different places they could be found.
