Hello,

In English, we have finished our Greek myths. The children have spent all week completing their myths and they are absolutely fantastic! All the children have included a variety of sentence openers, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, brackets, speech and connectives! They have all put in a great deal of effort and they are proud of what they have produced.

In Maths, we have been working on a variety of mathematical skills. The children have solved 1 and 2 step word problems, converted between the 12hr and 24hr digital time, solved problems using a timetable and solved time word problems.

In topic this week, the children have continued our topic 'Locational Knowledge'. The children have been comparing Sheffield to Maidstone, looking at what human features there are in both cities e.g. cinema, theatres, football stadiums.

In RE this week, we have told the story of Noah from Genesis 6:5 - 9:17. We acted the story out (which was very dramatic) and we made a list of the qualities Noah had, that made God choose him and the actions Noah carried out in obedience to God's commands.
