The children have been measuring this week in maths. They have looked at capacity, weight and length. During the capacity activity they were learning about volume and comparing sizes of a variety of containers, to estimate which would hold the most and least water. They also measured other people in the class to see how tall they were and converted their measurements from metres to centimetres. It was interesting to see them using kitchen scales and finding things that weighed as near to 200g as they could around the classroom.

In English the children planned their very own Horrid Henry story. I have to say they came up with some very funny ideas and I really enjoyed reading them. In SPaG they looked at conjunctions and connectives to extend a sentence and make it more descriptive.

We hope that you are able to join us for the class Act of Worship next week. We are looking at the Christian value 'trust.'

I am hoping to have a run-a-mile morning with the class next term which myself and the Year 6 sports leaders are currently organising. I will send a letter out with more information nearer the time, however the only difference for the children is that on that morning they will come into school a little earlier if convenient.

Your child may have told you that they were 'tree hugging' on Monday! They were...to enable them to feel the properties of the tree and discuss the requirements for an object to be alive. They particularly enjoyed this and were even able to identify some of the trees from their leaves.
