I hope you have had a great week. The children have certainly produced some fantastic work.

In English, we have continued our book 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. The children have planned and written a non-chronological report on chocolate and we have written a recount of Mike Teavee's journey into television. We have also started to compose our own oompaloompa songs. The writing this week has been excellent!

In Maths, we have been working on a variety of mathematical skills. The children have worked extremely hard this week, as we have covered a lot of areas! We have solved problems involving time conversions, we have completed an arithmetic test, added and subtracted decimals, rounded decimals to whole numbers and we have been practising our short multiplication method.
