Hello,

The children have worked extremely hard this week and they have all produced some fantastic work.

In English, we have continued our book 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We have read 15 chapters so far and we have written from Willy Wonka's and Augustus Gloop's perspective and the children have written a set of instructions about a chocolate bar they have created - some very interesting ideas! We have also been focusing on SPaG; in particular determiners and speech marks.

In Maths, we have been working on a variety of mathematical skills. We have recapped rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, solved word problems using our written methods for addition and subtraction and we have been investigating lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.

In topic this week, the children have been learning about how the Olympics started. We have discovered the events they did, the religious aspect of the games and also the Greek God they were dedicated to.

We had our first Forest School this week and the children were amazing. Seeing them in that environment for the first time was brilliant; they were creative, energetic and very resourceful!
