Year 4 Newsletter

Hello,

The children have worked extremely hard this week and they have all produced some fantastic work.

In English, we have continued our book 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We have now entered the chocolate factory and we lost 2 children! The children have written a setting description of a room in the chocolate factory, planned a story involving the character they created and have written the opening to it. We have also entered a competition where the children had to create their own superhero; the prize is a visit from the authors Greg James and Chris Smith.

In Maths, we have been working on a variety of mathematical skills. We have recapped lines of symmetry, compared and classified 2D shapes, used our place value to multiply multiples of 10/100 (e.g. 3000×7) and we have learnt the written method for division.

In topic this week, the children have been learning about the 'Battle of Marathon'. The children have started to look at the two territories of Athens and Sparta before next week, when they will be organising the timeline of how the battle happened.

For home learning this week, I would like the children to learn their times tables. Can the children quickly revise their 2, 5 and 10s, before moving onto their 3, 4 and 6 times tables please? I have made some MyMaths sheets available to complete, also there are lots of times table songs in YouTube which will help the children learn them.
