Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Proposed Residential Visit to Hardelot, France 10th to 12th July 2017

I am pleased to say that we have provisionally booked the Hardelot residential centre for two nights from Monday 10th July to Wednesday 12th July 2017. This date is obviously later in the year than our previous trips to France; unfortunately the centre is fully booked during May and June. Rather than lose this exciting opportunity for active learning in a different environment, we have provisionally booked at a later date. The cost will be in the region of £220.00 per child if all the children in the class join us on the trip, as we obviously hope they will. Once we know the exact numbers we can confirm the precise cost of the trip and at that stage we will then ask you for a non-refundable deposit to secure your child's place.

The price will include a coach to and from Leybourne, travel on the Eurotunnel, overnight accommodation at the Hardelot Centre, meals from Monday evening to Wednesday lunch (the children will need to bring a packed lunch on the first day) and all the activities and visits.

Planned activities include a trip to a farm, where the children will learn how to plait wheat plus visits to a chocolate factory, a goat farm, a sweet factory and a trip to Le Touquet Market. These trips may be subject to change, depending on the numbers.

I am acutely aware that the cost is a significant consideration, especially at the moment, and you will be able to pay for the trip in instalments. However, I am keen that no child should miss out due to financial concerns. *Please do speak to me in confidence if you have any concerns over the cost of the trip, as I will be able to help.*

As with all other school journeys we would encourage payment by instalments and will provide suggested instalment dates once the trip has been confirmed.

Obviously we would hold a parents meeting with you closer to the visit to discuss the trip in more detail. We now need to confirm the booking, and, in order for us to do so, I would be grateful if you would complete and return the attached form to school by **Friday 1st July 2016.**

We promote the learning and development of all children to achieve their full potential in a caring, happy, Christian environment.

If there is any aspect of the trip that you would like to discuss with me, please indicate on the form below so that the necessary arrangements can be made. Please be assured that there is no such thing as a silly question and I will be very happy to discuss any queries or concerns you may have.
