THIS WEEK'S LEARNING

English

This week, the children have been learning how to write instructions. They initially learnt a set of instructions orally and used actions to remember the different paragraphs. We then discussed features of instruction texts and highlighted that they need to be clear and to the point. The children learnt about imperative verbs, headings and subheadings, as well as time conjunctions. On Wednesday, we made Roman bread in preparation for writing an effective set of instructions for how to make bread.

Maths

This week, the children have been busy practising their mental maths - they have been adding, subtracting, halving and doubling. They have also been learning about 2-D shapes. They have learnt about polygons, quadrilaterals and triangles as well as about acute, obtuse and right angles. The children also had to differentiate between equilateral, isosceles and scalene triangles. When baking bread, the children practised measuring and weighing.
