THIS WEEK'S LEARNING

English

The children were this week introduced to the myth "Theseus and the Minotaur". We discussed features of a hero and together thought of, and collected, good quality adjectives. The children made a 'Hero Wanted' poster and later in the week they wrote a diary entry as Theseus. We have looked at past and present tense, pronouns and the possessive apostrophe in our SPAG lessons.

Maths

We have continued working on Place Value this week. The children have been partitioning and ordering numbers, as well as rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We have also looked at negative numbers. We are practising the times tables using songs which the children seem to enjoy.

Science

We looked at changes in matter this week and discussed whether all changes can be reversed. The children got messy when they put their hands into a cornflour and water mixture - they found out that when squeezed hard it is a solid but when you let go it becomes a liquid. We had a discussion as to whether this change would be reversible or not.

RE

We looked at the work of The Bible Society this week. The children found out why it was set up and how they translate, make and distribute Bibles all over the world. The children then wrote messages they would send to people across the world.
