THIS WEEK'S LEARNING

English

The children have been hard at work, writing their own myth this week. They have had to think about including several aspects of good writing in their story, for example; adjectives, expanded noun phrases, ambitious vocabulary and inverted commas, as well as varied punctuation.

Maths

The children have been practising using column subtraction this week. They have been solving word problems requiring the use of the column method. We have also been practising mental maths; adding, subtracting, finding the difference, multiplying by 10 and 100. Some of the children also played Roman numeral bingo.

Science

The grass the children planted has started to grow and we discussed how their pot represents the water cycle. We had a discussion about the water we drink, use in cooking and flush away - the children were not too impressed with the fact that we are using the same water as the dinosaurs did thousands of years ago! The children have been busy drawing the water cycle in a raindrop and labelling using scientific vocabulary.
