

Mathematics

In Maths this term, the children will be studying time, looking at how to read the time on an analogue clock with increasing accuracy. We will also be looking at a range of problems that involve calculating lengths of time.

We will also be looking at angles, recognising that they are a feature of a shape, as well as identifying different degrees of a turn and whether it is more or less than a right angle. We will learn about fractions, looking at adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators.

Physical Education

We will have two PE slots a week, on a Thursday and Friday morning.

We will be focusing on hockey and gymnastics. Our hockey sessions will be continuing this term, revising the skills learnt already as well as adding to these to build up to playing a game. We will also be focusing on gymnastics, looking at ways of travelling and sequences.

Science

In Science we will be learning about Forces and Magnets.

We will be looking at how different materials can affect how things move across the surface and we will discuss friction.

We will also experiment using magnets and learn about the different poles, as well as how they repel and attract each other why they might attract some materials and not others.

Year 3 - Term 3

English

In English this term, we will be using texts linked to our topic, such as The Scarabs Secret and other non-fiction texts.

The children will be looking at different text types this term, thinking about the composition and the reason that some may be used. They will be using example texts to create their own pieces of writing.

We will also be focusing on different areas of SPAG to help us to continue to improve our writing. We will also be looking at reading comprehension, as this will help us to understand what we are reading. We will learn to think about what the author may mean, even though it hasn't been written

Topic

This term we will focus on Ancient Egyptians. We will be linking History and Geography as we will be learning about where Egypt is and some of the features, such as the Nile which was so important to the lives of the people that lived there. We will also be learning about the society, Pharos, Gods and Goddesses, Hieroglyphics and much more.

Art and Design Technology will also be a factor of the topic, where the children will be creating Cartouches, Egyptian portraits and much more.

Computing

In computing, we will be looking at e-safety and the importance of remaining safe when using technology, as well as what to do if something happens online that we are not happy with. We will also be learning about online surveys, learning why they are used and we will be creating our own survey linked to an aspect within school. We will be thinking about what makes a good survey as well as the importance of using different questions to gather data.

Religious Education

In RE the children will be learning about Jesus. We will be learning about what Jesus was like and about different stages of his life. We will also be looking at him as a baby, through to what he was like as a leader.

Music

We will have music once a week which will be taught by Mrs Velvick. This term the children will be learning about performing rhymes, with links to English. They will learn to recognize the form of the poem such as verse, chorus, verse, as well as other rhyming forms.

By the end of the term, the children will have the opportunity to perform different pieces that they have practiced and learnt using body percussion, voices and instruments.

Italian

The children will be learning objects around the classroom, how to recognize whether a word is a 'female' or 'male', plural or singular. We will learn how to use the correct article for each of the objects. We will also be using the words we know to build sentences as well as practicing the numbers to 100.

We will be continuing our learning friendships. We will be learning about what it means to be a good friend, and thinking about being in another person's shoes when they might feel sad.
