

Mathematics

Fraction:

- Count up and down in tenths, recognise that tenths arise from dividing an object into 10 equal parts and in dividing one-digit numbers or quantities by 10
- Compare and order unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators
- Solve problems that involve all of the above.

Multiplication and division:

- Write and calculate multiplication and division calculations using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division.

Measurement:

- add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts

English

In English this term, we will be using texts linked to our topic, and other non-fiction texts.

The children will be completing a newspaper report about aspects linked to the Ancient Egypt topic, as well as a non-chronological report.

We will also be focusing on different areas of SPAG to help us to continue to improve our writing. We will also be looking at reading comprehension as this will help us to understand what we are reading as we will be able to think about what the author may mean, even though it hasn't been written.

Religious Education

In RE the children will be learning about Easter and how Jesus' leadership was powerful, but peaceful.

Italian

This term we will be learning the names for the members of the family and we will be making our Italian family tree. We will learn possessive and how to use them. We will also revise the different parts of the body and we will be building up sentences using the parts of the body and possessive.

Physical Education

We will have two PE slots a week, on a Thursday and Friday morning.

We will be focusing on 'ball skills' and building up our core strength.

During these units we will be developing our coordination skills as well as our core strength to help with our balance.

We will also have 2 sessions of Forest School where we will be able to explore the outdoor area and learn about the environment

Year 3 - Term 3 and 4

Topic

This term we will continue to focus on Ancient Egyptians. We will be linking History and Geography as we will be learning about where Egypt is and some of the features, such as the Nile which was so important to the lives of the people that lived there. We will also be learning about Tutankhamun, Pharaohs, Gods and Goddesses and much more.

Art and Design Technology will also be a factor of the topic, where the children will be creating necklaces, mummies and much more.

Science

In Science we will be finishing our learning about Forces and Magnets, as well as Rocks and Soils.

Magnets:

- Describe magnets as having 2 poles
- Predict whether 2 magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.

Soils:

- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

Computing

In computing, we will be finishing off our 'opinion pollsters' unit.

By the end of this unit the children will be able to;

- Understand some of the elements of survey design.
- Understand some of the ethical aspects of data collection
- Gain skills in using charts to analyse data.
- Gain skills in interpreting results.

Music

The children will continue to sing a range of songs. They will be learning to read standard musical notation, and perform on a variety of instruments, including the ukulele. The children will have the opportunity to listen to a range of music, including that of well-known composers, using their (developing) musical vocabulary, when describing and evaluating the music they have heard. Vocabulary: pitch, tempo, dynamics, rhythm, texture and structure.

SMSC and British Values

The children will be exploring democracy and the Rule of Law, which will be linked to our topic. We will compare and contrast this to the United Kingdom.
