In Maths, we have continued working with data and we have been learning to solve problems using a timetable and tables. We have also been learning about volume, using 1cm cubes to find the volume of cubes and cuboids.

In English, we have continued our poem, 'The Highwayman'. The children have written a recount of the poem from a character's viewpoint and the children became journalists, reporting on the poem in a newspaper report.

In History, we have continued our topic of the Tudors. We have learnt what the Tudors did for entertainment, as well as food, drink and education. We discussed this as a class and compared it to what we have today.

For home learning, I would like the children to complete an arithmetic test. This is in their homework folders and we have gone through the questions together.
