This week in Maths, Year 6 have solved word problems involving long multiplication and long division. The children rounded whole numbers and decimals, they compared decimals, fractions and percentages and had to add, subtract, divide and multiply fractions in order to solve clues and find the punchline for a joke! Our work in English mainly involved planning and writing two pieces of writing - a descriptive recount about a storm at sea and a newspaper report about the Mary Celeste. The children worked really hard and produced great results. In RE, we compared the teachings of the Sikh's special book, the Guru Granth Sahib, and the Bible. We found that they are remarkably similar.
