

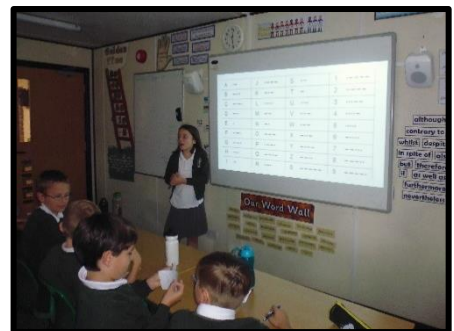
Year 6 letter
