Dear Parents and Carers,

First of all, we would like to thank all of you who were able to come and watch the Key Stage One Nativity. The children were so excited to perform to you and they all did an amazing job as twinkling stars!



In phonics this week, we focused on the different 'T' sounds. We know that there are lots of different ways that it can be spelt, for example: ie (fly a kite), igh (switch off the light it's night), ie (as in pie) and there are also some words that sound like an 'T', but are spelt with a y!

In Maths, we have begun to think about how to find half of an even number. We know that halving a number will make the starting number smaller. We have been using counters to help us to halve different numbers to demonstrate this in our work.

In Art, we have been creating our Christmas cards. We have had to think carefully about the techniques that we have used, as well as taking a lot of care with our work. The children are looking forward to taking these home for you to see next week!
