

Year 6 letter

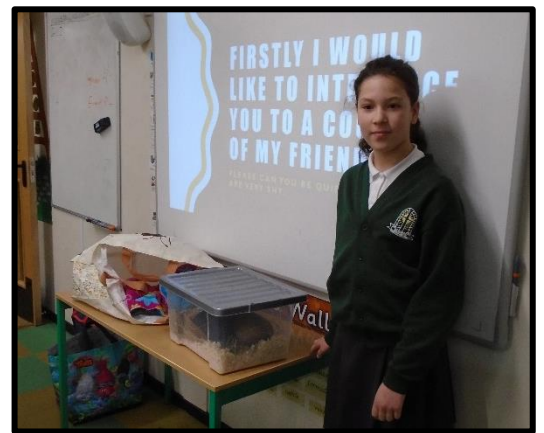
Dear Parents,
