

Year 6 letter

Dear Parents,

We have had a busy couple of weeks in Year 6, but the children have settled in really well. In maths, they carried out a couple of investigations, which involved continuing patterns and identifying and using formulae. We looked at place value, then revised written methods for addition, subtraction and short division. The children then solved word problems involving decimal numbers. In English, we have already read quite a lot of 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas'. Written tasks have included writing a description of an imaginary scene and a diary entry. We also made a rope swing in the playground, before writing a detailed set of instructions. Our first science topic is 'Light.' So far, the children have found out about light sources and we carried out a simple investigation to prove that light travels in a straight line.

The children now have spellings to learn for tests, which will take place every Friday. Your support with helping your child to learn these words would be much appreciated.
