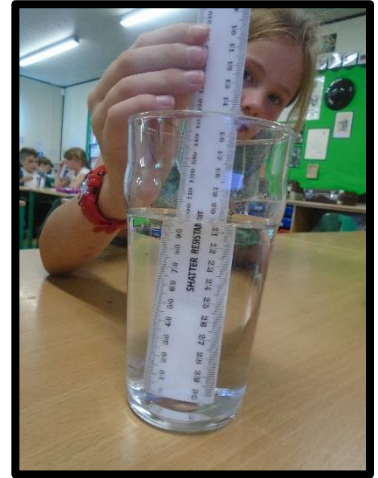


Year 6 letter

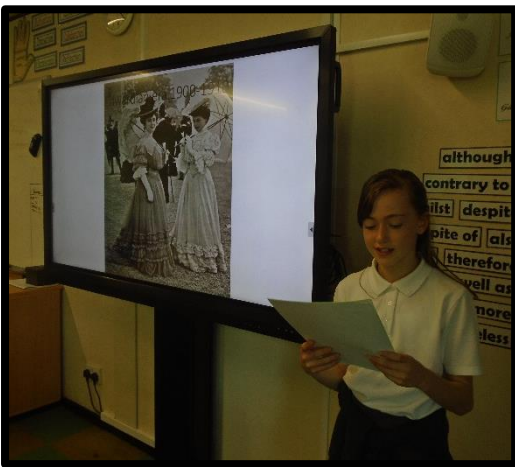
Dear Parents,

Home Learning

Most children should be able to complete the whole sheet in ten minutes, in which case, they should challenge themselves to get faster and faster - two minutes is the Year 6 record!
