I hope you have had a great week.

In English, we have continued our book, 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. The children have written a letter of apology on behalf of the character they created, a newspaper report, a persuasive argument asking to win the chocolate factory and they have created their own Oompa-Loompa songs.

In Maths, we have been working on a variety of mathematical concepts. We have been using the addition and subtraction method to solve word problems, we have solved problems using a bar chart and a pictogram, solved problems using a broken calculator and we have been dividing 1 and 2 digit numbers by 10 and 100.

In Topic, we have been learning about Boudicca and the threats she posed to the Roman Empire. The children have also been discussing the different opinions of her from the Celts and the Romans and how she would have been described through different points of History. We have also looked at different inventions the Romans created such as the Roman baths and the sponge on a stick! We have also been creating our own Roman mosaics and our own designs for a Roman vase.



For home learning this week, I would like the children to complete the MyMaths sheet on bar charts and pictograms. This should be completed by 19th October 2018. The children are also learning spelling list 4, for their test on Thursday 18th October.
