Dear Parents,

Thank you for your donations for the harvest festival. The children sang really well and had fun at the same time!

This week in maths, the children have been securing a written method for division. This can sometimes prove to be a challenge and I try to encourage the children to think about how they can use their times tables knowledge for support. They now have a written method and we will re-visit it at regular intervals.

In English this week, the children finished listening to the class reading book 'Charlotte's Web.' On Monday afternoon they watched the film to get an idea of what the characters were like. They really enjoyed reading about the friendship between Charlotte and Wilbur and could describe each character in detail. Once they had finished the story, the children completed their personal book review; they were able to discuss their favourite parts of the story and decide who would enjoy reading it.

In RE the children have been learning what it means to make a covenant. They have a good understanding of some of the promises God made to Noah and Abraham from the Old Testament. This week the children thought about promises they have made to people and what symbols of peace God sent to show everything would be fine. They made doves and wrote their own messages of peace.

I am sending home a sheet with the first 100 high frequency words; this is their home learning for the holidays. I will be completing a series of tests over the next couple of weeks; this is just to encourage them to focus on spelling them correctly in their writing. They are familiar with quite a few of them already.
