I hope you have had a great week. I can't believe that it's October already!

In English, we have continued our book 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. The children have written their own short story about the character they created. The stories were absolutely brilliant and the children should be proud of them. We have also learnt about homophones in our SPaG lessons.



In Maths, we have been working on a variety of mathematical concepts. We have been solving division calculations using our short division method, recapping our 6 times tables with the help of 'Fred the Red', we have created our own bar charts using data we collected and we have been multiplying multiples of 10 and 100 e.g. 3000×7 .

In Science, we have continued our topic, 'States of Matter'. We have been learning about the water cycle. We have created our own water cycle wheels explaining the 4 stages it undertakes and next week, we will be creating our own water worlds to show how this happens on a smaller scale.



In Forest School, the children have created their own Roman road, used Roman paints, created dens, played in the stream and lit a fire. The children really enjoyed today's adventure and took a lot from this. Thank you to our volunteers who helped run today's session, your help is very much appreciated!
