Dear Parents,

It was great to see so many of you at the Act of Worship on Tuesday. We hope you enjoyed it; the children worked hard and came up with lots of the ideas themselves. It was also nice to meet some of you at the parents' evenings and I hope that you are pleased with the progress your children are making, as I am! I would like to say that I feel the children have settled in beautifully to life in Year 3 and it is great to see them happy and engaged in their learning.

This week in maths, the children have continued to think about and practise measuring. They used rulers to measure lines and work out perimeters of a variety of shapes. At the start, they found it a challenge to remember to convert mm into cm when they were adding sides that were above 9mm. We continued to practise this throughout the week to ensure they developed a greater understanding.

In English, the children have been putting all their Ancient Egyptian knowledge into a booklet. They have been writing under sub-headings about the things they have learnt so far in topic, along with their favourite facts and information from the school trip. After writing a few sections, they will be collating the facts next week into their own information booklet. The children will also develop some of their pictures and facts during computing.

For home learning this week I have sent the children's 'Go To' books home, I would like them to copy the sentences in their books from the SPaG sheet, inserting punctuation correctly where needed.

The children are having singing practice for the Christmas performance and are busy learning all the songs, along with our class song. It feels very Christmassy in Year 3 already!

In PE this week we have continued to do gymnastics. Unfortunately I am unable to get the apparatus out whilst the stage is up; we will make up for this in term 3.
