Year 4 Newsletter

Hello

I hope you had a wonderful week.

In English, we have been writing a variety of poems. This week, the children have written a poem using onomatopoeia and we have extended sentences by using personification, similes and metaphors. We have also begun learning about the legend, 'Romulus and Remus'. We have read the story and retold the main events using a storyboard.

In Maths, we have been working on fractions this week. We have been counting in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 10, 25, 100 and 1000 and we have been solving one and two step addition word problems. The children have worked extremely hard this week.

In Science, we have been learning about condensation and how it occurs. The children have completed a worksheet on the water cycle and its components and then used that information to describe how condensation occurs in different situations.

In Topic, the children have been continuing to learn about volcanoes. They have labelled a cross-section of a volcano and they have been locating volcanoes on a world map using an atlas to help them.

The children have enjoyed Forest School today and they have shown great resilience, co-operation, perseverance and motivation to complete various projects - they love being outdoors!

Next Friday, we are going to Leybourne Grange to watch their Nativity. It can get quite cold whilst we are walking to the centre and whilst we are there, so can the children pack extra layers to keep warm and to wear wellies or old shoes as it can get muddy.

For home learning this week, I would like the children to continue to learn a poem to recite to the class for their performance on Monday 3rd December. The children are also to learn spelling list 10 for their test next week and to go on TT Rockstars to continue to learn their times tables.
