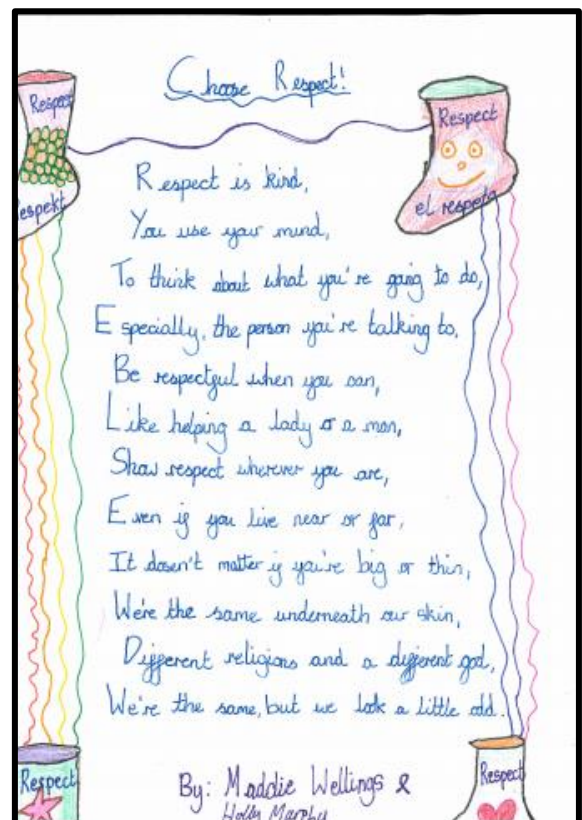
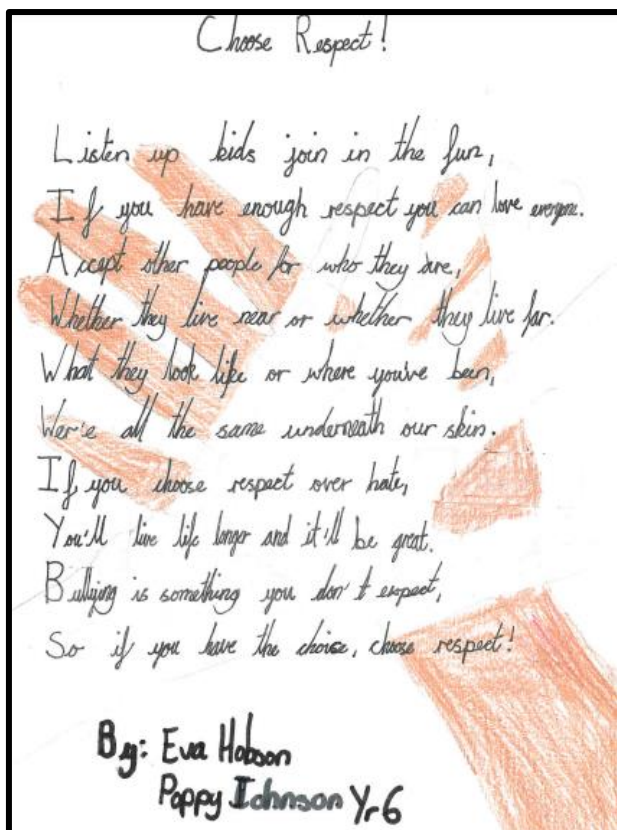


## Year 6 letter

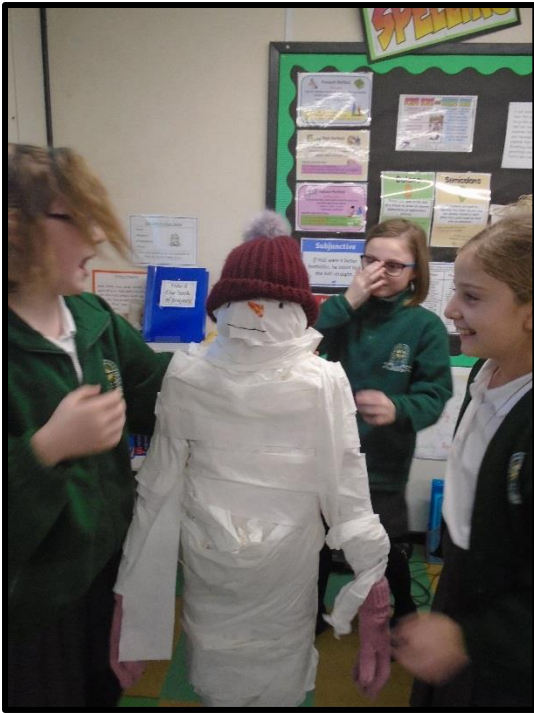

### Teacher of the Week

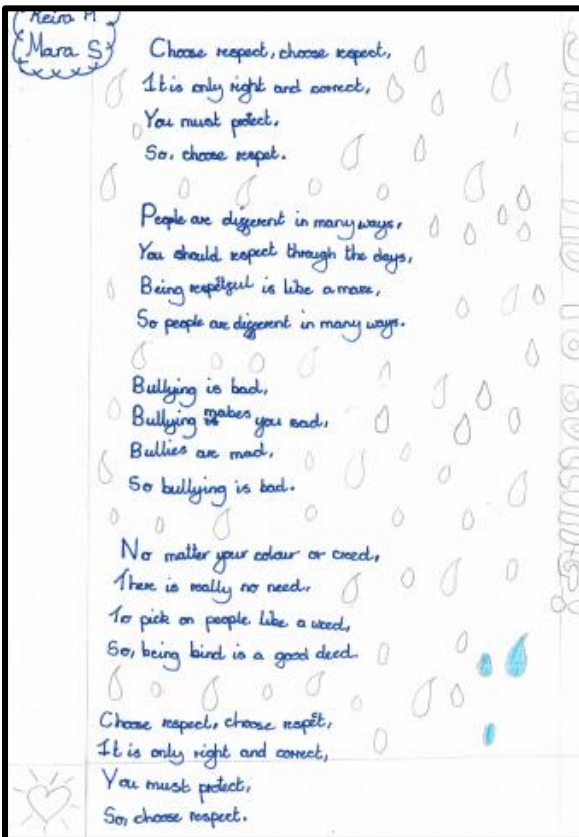

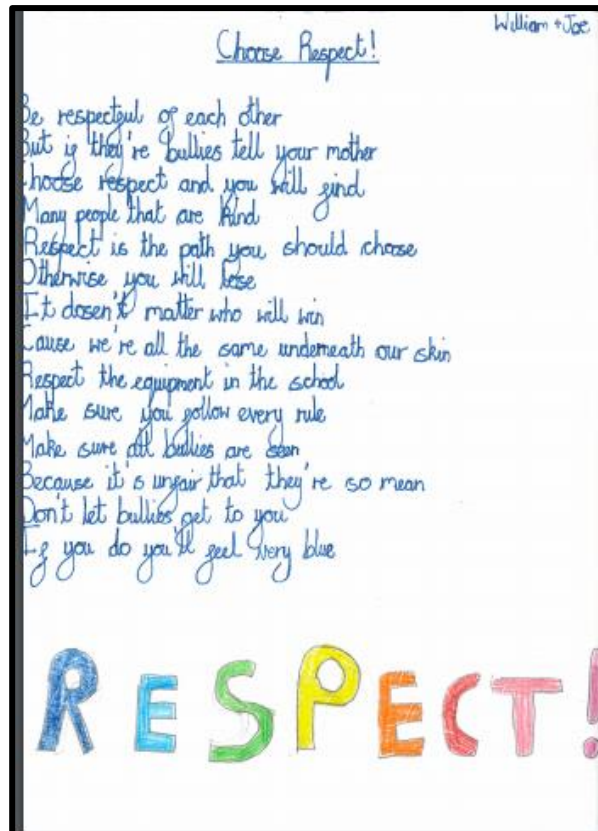
Home Learning
