Hello

I hope you had a wonderful week.

In English, we have been learning about the legend, 'Romulus and Remus'. We have written a recount from the perspective of King Amulius's servant, we have answered a reading comprehension about the story and we have used drama to retell the story by capturing an event using freeze-frames and discussing how the event would have affected the characters involved.

In Maths, we have been working on solving word problems involving addition, subtraction and division. We have also been solving word problems where we need to interpret remainders. The children have worked hard on this difficult concept.

In Science, we have completed an investigation on water temperatures and their surroundings. We had 3 bowls of water (boiling, ice cold and room temperature) and we left them on the same place in the classroom. We then took the temperature at various times in the afternoon to investigate how water changes temperature to its surroundings.

In Topic, the children have been continuing to learn about volcanoes. They have labelled a cross-section of the Earth and they have created warning signs to be put near a volcano.

As we return from Leybourne Grange, I am confident that the children will have enjoyed themselves thoroughly. The children always show a fantastic level of respect and I am sure that today will be no different. Thank you to the parents who volunteered to help walk the children to Leybourne Grange - it is very much appreciated!
