First of all, we would like to thank all of you who were able to come and watch the Key Stage One Nativity. The children were so excited to perform to you and they all did an amazing job as twinkling stars!

In Maths, we have been revising how to partition numbers to highlight what each of the digits within a number really means. We have also been looking at and trying to find different ways we can make whole numbers. We were given a number e.g. 8 and we had to find all of the possible ways of making 8 by adding two numbers together. This was much trickier than we thought it would be, but we found that working systematically helped us to keep track of calculations we had and hadn't found.

In Art, we have been creating our Christmas cards. We have had to think carefully about the techniques that we have used, as well as taking a lot of care with our work. The children are looking forward to taking these home for you to see next week!
