In maths this week, we began by telling the time using individual clocks. We practised telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. We also discussed how we can count around the clock in fives to help us tell the time to the nearest five minutes. We also practised measuring capacity in millilitres by reading scales on measuring jugs. First of all, we had to work out what the increments represented (e.g. were they going up in 1's, 2's, 5's or 10's) before we could accurately work out the measurements.

We had a big focus on SPaG this week. We began by looking closely at how to punctuate our writing correctly using full stops, capital letters, exclamation and question marks. We also looked at how we add the suffixes 's' or 'es' when changing nouns from singular to plural.

We had a very wet but very fun forest school session this morning with Mrs Murray. We made Christmas decorations, dug for dinosaur bones, found lots of wiggly worms and created our own shelters.

We have been working very hard in our Nativity rehearsals this week and can't wait to perform to you all next week!

I thought it would be a bit mean if I tested the children on spellings and times tables next week with all the Christmas activities going on, so there will be no more spellings or times tables tests until after Christmas!

Thursday 13th December is Christmas dinner day. Children can come to school dressed in Christmas jumpers!
