Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year! We hope you all had a wonderful Christmas ☺

This term in Year 1, our topics are:

- **Castles and Fairytales**, where we will be learning about traditional tales, features of a castle, what it was like to live in a medieval castle and facts about Queen Elizabeth I and other members of the Royal family.
- **Everyday Materials** for science. We will be identifying, naming and sorting a variety of materials, looking at the properties of these materials and testing them.

It's been lovely welcoming the children back to school this week and hearing about their exciting holidays! We began our topic of Castles and Fairytales by reading and retelling the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We imagined what wonderful things we would like to discover at the top of a beanstalk. We worked on including interesting adjectives in our writing, to make it more exciting to read. We have also been working on the presentation of our writing, taking our time to ensure that our letters are being formed correctly.

In maths, we began by finding ten more, or less, than a number up to 100. We have been using a 100 square to help our learning. We found out that when adding, or subtracting 10, the units number does not change, only the digit in the tens column.

In science, we began our topic of everyday materials. We discussed the different types of materials that objects from the classroom were made from. Then we collected a variety of objects and sorted them into groups depending on what material they were made from. We found that some of the items could fit into more than one group, as they were made from more than one material.
