In English, we have finished our book, 'The Iron Man'. The children have written a newspaper report about the Iron Man's victory over the Space-Bat-Angel-Dragon, written a set of instructions on how to build your own Iron Man and completed a reading comprehension. The children have also been improving sentences by adding adjectives, adverbs and fronted adverbials to make the sentences interesting.

In Maths, the children have been using their multiplication method to solve problems, finding factors of numbers, interpreting and drawing tables and solving problems using bar charts. We have also been to the ICT suite to continue using TT Rockstars.

In Science, we have continued our new topic 'Electricity'. The children have been investigating appliances, which have materials which are conductors on the inside and insulators on the outside. The children then built circuits with several different components.
