In English, we have started our new book, 'Billionaire Boy', by David Walliams. This week, we have written a recount about a dream birthday party and a diary entry from Joe's perspective about his birthday. We have also completed a reading comprehension about the first chapter and organised events from the second. In SPaG we have discussed synonyms, homophones and similes and how we can use them in our writing.

In Maths, the children have been dividing money using the bus stop method and solving word problems around this. The children have also completed an arithmetic test and they have divided one-digit and two-digit numbers by 10 or 100.

In Science this week, we started our new topic, 'Sound'. The children explored how sounds are made and then conducted a sound survey around the school to determine where the loudest place was.
