In English, we have continued our new book, 'Billionaire Boy', by David Walliams. This week, we have written a conversation between the head master and Mr Spud, a letter asking the head master to ban Mrs Strife's school dinners and an interview from Joe's perspective about how he feels about everyone knowing he is rich. We have also completed a variety of SPaG activities and reading comprehensions about the book.

In Maths, the children have completed a reasoning maths paper, solved word problems involving time and all four written methods and the children have been solving time problems using a timetable.

In Topic, the children have been reading maps and using the compass directions to find places on a map. The children then created their own treasure maps on the field using the compass points to set clues for their friends.



In Science this week, the children have created pan pipes! They used glue and straws to create the musical instrument, focussing on how they can make higher or lower sounds - the children really enjoyed making these!
