

Year 1 Home Learning



Dear Parents and Carers,

For maths this week, we have been revising our place value to ensure that we are confident with numbers and what each of the digits actually means. E.g. 12 has 1 ten and 2 ones.

We have been using different resources to help us to understand the value of 2 digit numbers. One of the methods we used to help to show the number visually is ten frames. We knew that once we had filled all 10 squares of one frame, we didn't need to count each individual counter. We used counting in tens to support our thinking. Once we had counted in tens, we had to remember to count in ones for any frames that were not completely filled.

e.g. 18 would be represented as:



Last week in Forest School, we were lucky enough to have found several dragon eggs hidden around the forest; however, we were unable to find any of the baby dragons. This week in our English lessons, we have been creating a missing poster to help to find our dragons. We had to think of interesting adjectives to help describe our dragon's appearance and personality. We also had to think about where our dragon could be hiding!

We have continued to practise building sentences and using full stops correctly this week. We had a lot of fun imagining what the dragons could look like and using this to create our missing posters.

In phonics, we have been practising reading real and pseudo words. The children can continue to practise this using the games on the Phonics play website.
