We have been learning about life cycles this week in Science and have found out that animals, including humans, have offspring. The children have been able to recognise a variety of life cycles.

For maths this week, we have been ordering numbers: greatest to smallest, smallest to greatest and shortest to longest. We have been practising using our < > and = signs and we are getting more confident. Next week, we will be counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s and will be having an end of unit check to see what we have learned.

In Forest School on Tuesday we had great fun learning how to light fires safely. We will be making bread next time, linking to our Great Fire of London topic, and burning houses - made out of cereal boxes - to demonstrate how the fire spread so easily.

Forest School - Our next Forest School session will be on Tuesday 15th October.

Spelling and table test scores will be with you on Monday. I am spending time with each child to make sure they are learning what is appropriate for them. I worked with some children today, so their scores came home in their bags at the end of the day. I will be letting you know which table your child should focus on, via the Reading Record Book.
