In maths, this week, we have been busy counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. We have been finding 2 less, 2 more, 5 less, 5 more and 10 less, 10 more. We then completed our end of unit check; I will give you some feedback (next week), once I have gone through them all in detail.

We will be moving on to addition and subtraction: we had a go at some addition problems today, aiming to earn as many marbles as possible! We will be using our  $<$   $>$   $=$  signs to make number sentences correct:  $10 + 4 < 18$ ,  $9 + 2 > 9$ , and  $10 + 2 = 9 + 3$

Social issues: Mrs Holditch and I have been made aware, this week, of a few issues occurring during break and lunch times. With the support of Mrs Newington, we have taken time to solve the problems. Please encourage your child to make sure they have let a member of staff know when an issue has arisen. Mrs Holditch has also spoken to a few children who have been referring to members of the lunchtime staff by their first names, reminding them that this is not appropriate.

Next Tuesday afternoon, Year 2 (and above) will enjoy a performance of the Hobbit, by a visiting theatre company – very exciting!

We have been reading more of 'Fing' and we are really enjoying it! The children have been writing about how they would help Mr Meek pack for the jungle: suggesting important items he should consider taking and why, especially as in the story, Mr Meek doesn't take enough food and has to eat his underpants!
