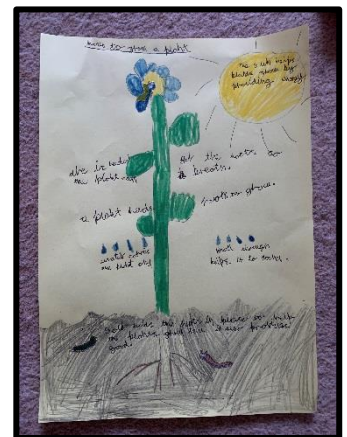

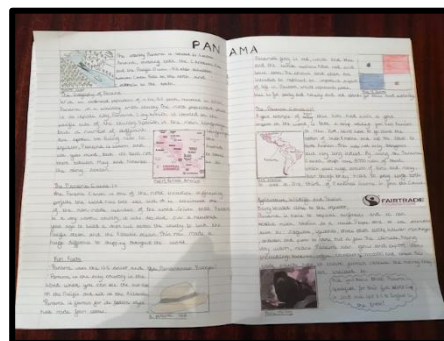

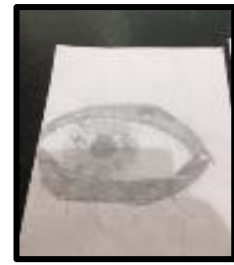

Tabby produced a very detailed non-chronological report about Panama

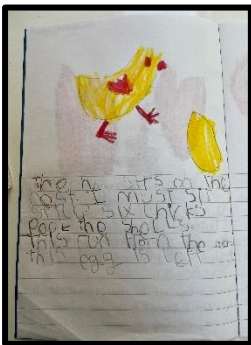

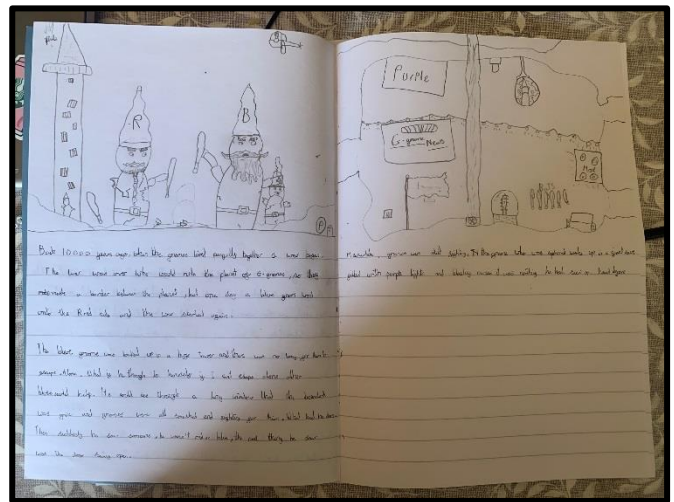
Some things the children have been making in Forest School this week.

and nights.

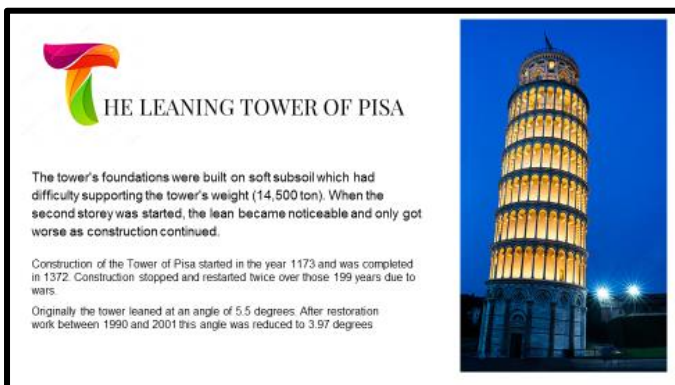
